NH Kids' Trout Camp is a co-ed program for ages 14 – 17 yrs.

- Camp days are filled with stream ecology, conservation, restoration and learning river safety, fly-fishing and fly-tying skills.
- NH Fish and Game Department staff assist in teaching conservation and stream ecology. NH licensed guides are some of the on-stream volunteers.
- On-Stream fishing in the Connecticut River headwaters offers rainbow, brook and brown trout as well as landlocked salmon.
- All Fly-Fishing equipment is provided including fly-tying kits.
- Cabin lodging is provided including 3 meals per day from Wednesday's dinner to Sunday's breakfast and healthy snacks.
- 1:1 student to counselor ratio. All counselors undergo National Trout Unlimited background check.

NH KIDS' TROUT CAMP July 14 – 18, 2010

Eight participants will be selected to attend the 2010 camp. Students are selected based on the content of their essays and letters of recommendation. NH TU Council's Selection Committee reviews the applications.



Camp tuition, room & board is \$425. All equipment required is provided at camp. Financial assistance (full and partial) is available. Tuition and financial assistance information will be provided after you receive an acceptance letter.
